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Supplies for Weaving

Cotton yarns for warp and weft, natural or white: suggested sizes 10/2, 8/2

5/2 perl cotton for gathering thread - any light color.

Warp width: approximately 12-14 "

Warp length 4-6 yards

Sett: For a firm, balanced plain weave (suggested setts: 10/2@ 24 epi, 8/2 20 epi) Please warp the looms, using one of the suggested threading.


Tie up: initially we will use only a plain weave. We will will alter tie-ups after we have had a chance to discuss the weaving.

Each weaver will need:

- 2 shuttles
- one pick-up stick
- two 1/2" dowels that are a couple inches longer than the width of your warp
- a tape measure
- scissors
- any other small weaving tools that you are accustomed to using.

Loom threading: Looms should be prepared with any of the suggested threading variations.

1. Monks Belt - 4 shafts




2. Point Twill - 8 shafts


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3. Extended Point Twill - 8 shafts

5. Bronson Lace Blocks - 4 shafts


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end and repeat
