You will need:

Sharp scissors 2 water containers

small black and small white craft acrylic paint 2oz.

acrylic paint in your favorite colors

A pencil

waxed paper

Assorted brushes

Paper- watercolor or acrylic, 9" x 12" tablet, 10-20 sheets (the more paper, the more prints) Canson Acrylic seems to work best unless you have printmaking paper-

BRING

thin cardboard – a cereal box or other recycled cardboard

Brayer if you have one

Cheese cloth, feathers, string, buttons, doilies (optional)

Rubber stamps (optional) Stamp pad (optional)

Large brown paper bag cut open to use as a surface to work on

Bring a lunch-sometimes we are busy and can't stop to go out-depends on location. Dress for messy work.
