Paint Colors

Ultramarine Blue or Primary Blue Cerulean Blue

Cadmium Red Medium of Cadmium Red Light or Pyrrole Red or Primary Red Alizarin Crimson or Quinacridone Magenta

Primary Yellow or Lemon Yellow

Cadmium Yellow Medium or Cadmium Yellow Dark

Cadmium Yellov Yellow Ochre Ivory Black Titanium White Burnt Umber

Brushes

Brushes are funny, they are numbered, but some brands use numbers for big that others use for small, so I would say to describe it like this:

- One brush that is synthetic that is about 1/2" wide, can be a flat or a filbert style
- One (synthetic) that is about 1/4" wide, either flat or filbert
- One (synthetic) small brush that is round

This would be the minimum. Two or three of the same size is fine and helpful. Sometimes Joann Fabrics sells a set by Royal Langnickel called Big Kids Choice and that is nice and not very expensive.

Canvas

Two- three canvases. Size suggested: 8x10 for the first class and then you can make a more informed decision for the rest of class. Typical sizes are 8x10, 9x12, 10 x 12, 11 x 14, 12 x 16. If your reference photo is a square consider a 12x12 canvas

Other

- Pad of palette paper or a Masterson Sta-wet Palette with the Acrylic Paper Refills, or a large plastic tray of some sort.
- Metal palette/mixing knife
- Water container- holds 2-2.5 quarts of water
- Bring an apron or paint shirt (or wear old clothes)
- Bring multiple photos of subjects you would like to explore
