## Prerequisite-

Must have taken two of Janet's metalsmithing workshops or comparable experience.

## STUDENTS to BRING:

- Beach stone or Cabochon Beach Stone should be 1" to 1½" round or oval that is flat on the bottom. Stone can be raw or polished. Raw stones can be "polished" with wax prior to setting.
- Any glasses needed for close work
- Any jewelers pliers you have (jewelers pliers are smooth on the inside)
- Apron if available
- Please wear older clothes was much of this work is messy and some involves acid
- Sack Lunch. Feel free to use the microwave or refrigerator in the kitchen on CTAC on the main floor.

## If you have the following please bring:

- small hammer
- small old screwdriver
- 1/4 chisel
- nail set tool
- old nails



## SUPPLIES PROVIDED:

Use of all of the tools needed to make a ring or pendant. An instruction handout covering the construction process, definitions and key tips and information. All workshop supplies needed for this project. This includes fine silver bezel wire, flat sterling silver to back the stone and create a ring band or bail, solder, pickle, flux and polishing materials. <u>A material fee (\$15-\$20) to</u> cover the silver used by each student is payable to the instructor.
