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## STUDENTS to BRING:

- Drawing paper & sharp pencil
- Fine tip black sharpie
- Beach stone - a 1" to 1½" round or oval beach stone that is somewhat flat on the bottom (or a cabochon)
- Any glasses/magnification needed for close work
- Small craft paint brush
- Paper towels
- Small soft cotton rag
- Dental Floss
- Small amount of masking tape or painters tape
- Fire starter or lighter
- White Out - Brush or Pencil OK
- Scotch Brite scouring pad
- Safety Glasses
- Small 2+ cup glass bowl for Pickle
- Small 1C plastic or glass bowl for water quench
- Apron to protect your clothing
- Wear older cotton (not nylon) clothing

## SUPPLIES PROVIDED:

Use of all of the tools needed to make a beach stone ring. An instruction handout covering the construction process, definitions and key tips and information. All workshop supplies needed for this project. This includes fine silver bezel wire, flat sterling silver to back the stone, an adjustable sterling ring mounting (sizes 6 1/2-9), solder, pickle, flux and polishing materials. A material fee (\$10-\$20) to cover the silver used by each student is payable to the instructor.
