Crooked Tree Arts Center is located at 322 Sixth Street in Traverse City. Free parking is available on the street and next to our building. Our entrance is barrier-free. We have a wheelchair accessible restroom and elevator.

Bring \$10 if you are participating in the project. Space is limited - you can register online or call us. Arrive at 5:30 p.m. The instructor will guide everyone through the project steps. You may also bring in your own art to share - we love to see your creations! Art Able ends at 6:30 p.m.
