

# Make your own "Tube of Paint"



## Materials

- Toilet paper tube
- 6"x8" Plaster Wrap- cut into four equal pieces
- 1/4 c. Celluclay
- Assorted paint brushes
- Acrylic paint- White, black, grey/silver and color of your choice!
- Small piece of wax paper or parchment paper
- Paint palette or paper plate
- Container for water
- Pencil
- Plastic spoon

## Optional

- Black Sharpie

Pinch and fold up one end of the tube.

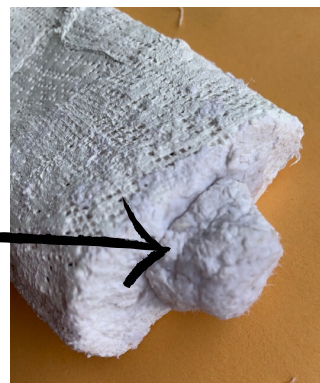


Cover tube with 4 plaster strips. Dip one square of plaster wrap into water. Lightly "mush" the strip to activate the plaster. Lay on the strips, overlapping slightly to ensure complete coverage. Your last plaster strip should cover the opening of the tube.



Mix Celluclay by slowly adding water with a spoon. Once mixed start to knead the clay with your fingers. Cover the opening with a thin layer of clay.

With a small amount of celluclay create a "smooshed" ball of clay. This will be where the paint squeezes out from.



Roll out clay that will be the paint that is squeezing out of the tube. Let dry overnight. In high humidity it may take longer to dry. Once dry add paint. Outline the paint tube with black paint to give it a cartoon look.
